Follow you again, my Lord!*

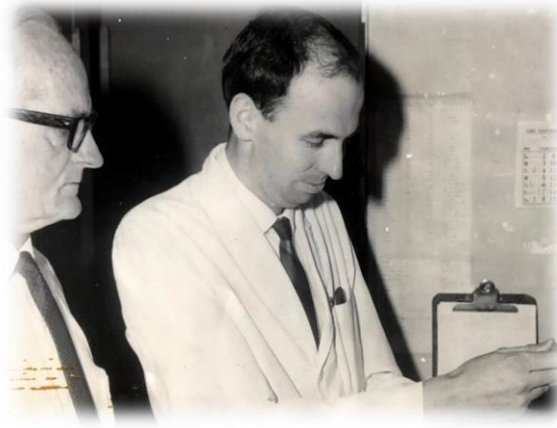
2. In my memories, I know

beyond the fears that close me in!

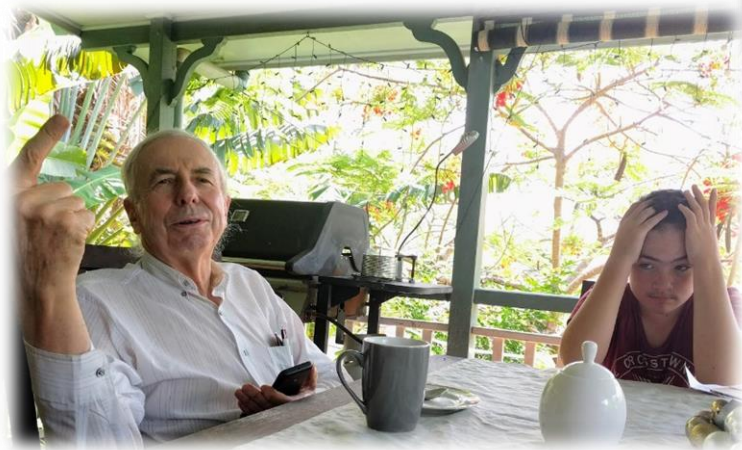
